# Studio News

### Hanging in the Studio/Gallery: Important tips.

- 1 When leaving paintings at the Studio please ensure that you label clearly whether they are intended for the Plant Farm or the Studio walls. As we have limited storage space this will help those who are hanging the exhibitions choose correctly.
- 2 If you leave more than one painting for either site please bundle them together to ensure that they cannot get separated. This will help ensure that your works are hung in the intended exhibition/s.
- 3 Clearly label your paintings on the back with the title, the medium, the price and your name.
- 4 Remember to sign the Painting Register when leaving your paintings and collect and remove paintings that were previously hung. There is no storage space in the Studio.

## Tips for a well hung painting

- (i)Measure 1/3 of the way down from the top of your frame or stretched canvas on the left and right sides and mark the spot where the screws will go;
- (ii) Make holes to insert screw eyes. Please do not use the ring and hook style screws as they do not lie flat and project out which becomes a danger to other works if and when stored against another's painting. Screw eyes or D-rings are the acceptable hanging method or stapled cords done by professional framers.
- (iii) Measure about 1 1/2 times the length of the space between the screw eyes for ensuring the correct length of wire/cord for hanging.
- (iv) Feed the wire or cord through the screw eyes and loop to fasten securely. If using wire, wrap the extra wire around itself ensuring that it is not protruding or hanging loose to cause injury or damage.
- (v)The wire should not come further than half way up the frame or canvas from the screw eyes.Test this from the middle of the wire or cord.

Frames are themselves considered a work of art as are the sides of stretched canvases. It is therefore important to ensure that when presenting a stretched canvas for hanging, either the painting should continue around the sides of the canvas or, alternatively, the sides should be painted in a single or toned colour or left clean. This method presents a more aesthetically pleasing appearance for an exhibition

# Please have you work at the Studio prior to the hanging time as it is difficult to find space for late entries.

Hanging days are always Mondays at 10am. Dates for the next Human Form exhibition in the studio will be on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March and the first day of the exhibition will be Tuesday 1 April with an official opening on Friday 4 April.
