### **Catherine Hamilton Portrait Workshop Report**

We held a second workshop for this year with Catherine Hamilton, on the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> November. Catherine is a renowned artist from Mornington Penninsula.

Following on from our acrylics and pastel workshops, we worked on Portraiture using charcoal drawing, paint rollers and acrylic paint. Her approach led us to introduce more freedom into traditional portraiture techniques, while at the same time making us consider carefully the marks we make in our artmaking, the colours, tones and intensity modified to control what becomes the focus of the composition. We had 14 participants in the class and everyone enjoyed themselves and learnt a lot.
