NEW STUDIO FURNITURE

At times making artworks can be very messy. It does depend on the techniques, materials and styles being used. The problem is we have some very damaged tables at the moment which are unsuitable for precise drawing and designing, watercolour, gouache and other works on paper.

The plan is to purchase some good, stable tables and to use protective easy-to-clean covers on them. Please help keep them in good condition by being vigilant in clean-ups after use. Some of the older tables will be kept for times when we are using expressive techniques with inks, acrylic paint, glues and oil paints. Please always be considerate of others and clean up as best as you can afterwards.

Thank you to those members who have offered to repair our present furniture, research the purchase of suitable new furniture and also those who have donated easels for our studio. Note that we can't always accept donated items. We need to consider the best use for the available studio space.

Postponed Workshop “Colour Mixing and Plant Portraits” Oct 19th & 20th.

Although many members expressed interest in a workshop that focussed on drawing techniques and colour mixing, only 3 registrations were received by the set date. It has been decided to postpone this workshop to a later date, even to early next year in the hope that the timing will suit more participants.

Please let the coordinator, Judy Balfour know if you are interested in attending a late summer/autumn workshop with the Beechworth artist Christine Cansfield Smith. Her workshop would be valuable to artists in any painting mediums, but especially for those starting out in watercolour.
