*The Forest Gallery is my home where my studio is nestled in the heart of the Wellsford forest near Bendigo Victoria.*

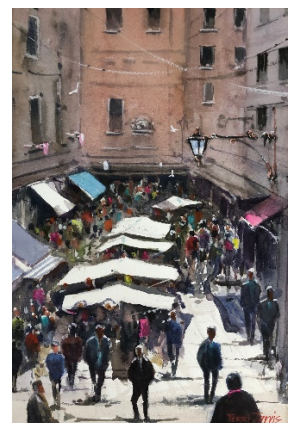
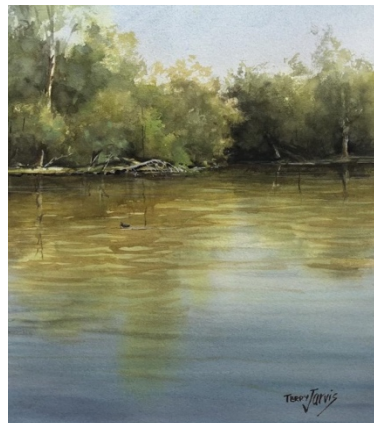
