Thank you to all members who attended our General Meeting and Special General Meeting on Wed 18th April, and supported the committee by voting in the requested changes to our Victorian constitution. It was great to have your agreement, and your committee can now proceed with the formal process of lodging the changes with Consumer Affairs Victoria.

Recently I have been travelling around a fair bit, to various parts of the country, and I have been lucky enough to see two outstanding exhibitions at smaller galleries – one in Cairns of works by Fred Williams of Weipa and Broome, and the second was a retrospective exhibition of works by Elizabeth Cummings in Newcastle. Both of these exhibitions are travelling exhibitions, are excellent, and I can recommend them if you come across them whilst travelling.

Also of interest, I have included some information later in this newsletter about the upcoming exhibition of botanical art in Canberra in May. This should be a truly beautiful exhibition, being part of a world wide exhibition of botanical art, and will be well worth the trip. THE AWAS CONSTITUTION- The May Special General Meeting

As members were notified last month, a Special General Meeting was held at the Paintbox Studio/Gallery just before our General Meeting. The purpose of the Special General Meeting was to consider changes to the Victorian Constitution. We adopted the following changes:-

- 1. Section 3 of the Victorian Constitution was changed to read as follows:- "The financial year of the Association is each period of 12 months ending 30th June".
- 2. Section 2 of the Victorian Constitution was changed to read as follows: The purposes of the association are:
 - to encourage members' artistic talents.
 - to share companionship and experience in a common endeavour.
 - to provide a range of activities to members and valuable learning experience.

Flora of Australia: A Botanical Art Worldwide Exhibition

The Botanical Art Society of Australia is participating in a groundbreaking collaboration between botanical artists, organizations, and institutions worldwide, creating and exhibiting botanical artworks of native plants found in each of 25 participating countries, representing artists and plants of six continents.


In Australia the exhibition will be held in Canberra at the Ainslie Art Centre, Braddon from 18 May to 27 May 2018 10am to 4pm daily.

Countries currently participating include Australia, Bermuda, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, France, Germany, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Republic of Korea, Russia, Scotland, Southern Africa, Thailand, Ukraine, United Kingdom and United States. Participating countries will provide digital slide shows of up to 40 works, to be compiled with all of the other countries images and shown at each venue during the run of the exhibition.

Entries were solicited from botanical artists across Australia and eventually one hundred and nine works were chosen to hang in the exhibition. From this group the 40 works have been selected to be sent digitally around the world for viewing in the other participating countries. These have been chosen to showcase both the talent of our botanical artists and the diversity of our native flora.
