Having just returned from Germany I must admit to feeling a little weary when writing this. In my absence Kathy and the committee have been doing a great job and I would like to thank them all for their input and commitment.

Even if my trip to Germany was just a short one, OF COURSE I managed to sneak in some visits to galleries and exhibitions whilst there. I must admit that my German is a bit rusty, but I still managed to get the gist of most of the works. And when I didn't, I was lucky enough to be visiting with someone a little more knowledgeable than I. One of the places we visited was an artists' colony in a small village called Worpswede, near Bremen in north Germany. 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EXHIBITIONS: Flora of Australia: A Botanical Art Worldwide Exhibition

CONGRATULATIONS to AWAS member JUDY BALFOUR! Her work was selected to be exhibited in this worldwide exhibition in Canberra! Two other local artists, Christine Cansfield-Smith from Beechworth and Marie-Van-Lint from Albury also have their work exhibited.

Botanical art exhibitions will be held in 25 countries in May, with 18^{th} May being Worldwide Botanical Art Day. The Australian exhibition of 110 paintings is being held in Canberra from $18^{th} - 27^{th}$ May with 110 paintings depicting species native to Australia.



JUDY BALFOUR'S PAINTING.

These are the seed pods of Pararchidendron pruinosum (common names include snow wood, monkey's earrings and tulip siris. They are legumes and when drying they curl up and spiral exposing the shiny black seeds. As you can see this curling is not uniform to every pod.

It is a small rainforest tree, growing from the Shoalhaven River in NSW to Herberton in north Queensland; also, in New Guinea and Indonesia.

We have one growing in the native section of the Albury Botanic Gardens and that is where my specimens came from (with the permission of Paul Scannell).

The painting is about A4 size and botanical art usually depicts the plant true to size. The painting was executed with watercolours.

AWAS member Alison Percy has an exhibition in Melbourne featuring her responses to the changing seasons in the Alpine and NE Victorian Landscape. The works feature her signature layering of calligraphic lines and beautiful harmonies of flat colour. 22 May to 2 June 2018 at Gallery fortyfive downstairs, 445 Flinders Lane, Melbourne. Tues-Fri 11am-5pm, Sat 12pm-4pm.
