The AWAS LIBRARY

It is noted that not many members are borrowing from the library, so here is some information to clarify the procedures and encourage you to make use of the library.

- **Books are arranged in categories and colour coded.** This should make it easier to locate books according to subject matter and return them to the correct place.
- Colour coding as follows:

Landscapes General and Australian Art – Orange Australian Artists – Orange & Black Portraiture – Yellow & Black Drawing and Painting Techniques – Yellow Collections - Red Impressionism – Green & Black Oils – Pink Pastels – Blue & Black Watercolours – Blue Acrylics - Purple International Artists - Green

DVD's are also colour coded

- Where there is a DVD accompanying a book, these are together in a plastic bag.
- Videos are on the narrow shelves in the storeroom (left hand side of the door).
- The Library catalogue is in the Library cupboard and is arranged in the categories (same as the shelves).
- **The Borrowers' Register** is in the white folder in the Library cupboard. Please ensure you write legibly. The author only needs to be listed if we have more than one book of the same title.
- Borrowing period is four weeks.
- **Returns** if you return the borrowed item/s just fill in the date in the returned column. If you return items for someone else, or more importantly if someone brings the borrowed item to the studio and gives it to you, please ensure you mark it off with the date in the returned column.

"Tudors to Windsors" traces the history of the British monarchy through the outstanding collection of the National Portrait Gallery, London. This exhibition highlights major events in British (and world) history from the sixteenth century to the present, examining the ways in which royal portraits were impacted by both the personalities of individual monarchs and wider historical change. Presenting some of the most significant royal portraits, the exhibition will explore five royal dynasties: the Tudors, the Stuarts, the Georgians, the Victorians and the Windsors shedding light on key figures and important historical moments.

To bring these royal figures to life, Bendigo Art Gallery has secured key loans of historic fashion, armour and personal effects which will be featured alongside these magnificent and imposing portraits."
