"Tudors to Windsors: British Royal Portraits" at the Bendigo Art Gallery from 16th March to 14th July. It was good to see the paintings and photographs of historical importance as well as admire the skilled workmanship.

Day 2. "Pastels - any subject" Steve Mc Call, from Bright, will be conducting these two workshops over one weekend in July. They will be held at the studio on 13th and 14th July. Members may do one day (either day) or do both days.

Saturday the 13th we will be "Snow is not white" using any medium; your choice. The medium doesn't matter as we will be concentrating on colour and tone - so interesting with a "white" subject. Just look at Steve's paintings below and you'll see all the colours.

Steve usually paints with acrylics and pastels; you may use other mediums as the same principles will apply. Here are some of Steve's paintings - the upper two are pastels and the lower two are acrylics. **Sunday 14th will be a pastels / mixed media workshop.** You choose your subject matter and bring photos and / or sketches. We will be underpainting (possibly a complimentary) to enhance the work, and to quickly establish the colours and tonal values.

OTHER ARTY OPPORTUNITIES FOR MEMBERS:

Copying artworks by famous artists is a great way to learn "how they did it". Traditionally this has been a great teaching tool. Most of you are aware there is now a trend for Fabulous Fakes being auctioned for charity, and AWAS has organized and participated in a few of these events in the past. Last newsletter we announced an invitation is extended to AWAS members to participate in a charity **"Fabulous Fakes" art auction held by the Sanctuary Refugee Group**.

Have you thought about what you will do? To comply with copyright laws, the chosen artist needs to have died before 1978. The artwork should be a different size to the original, so that there is no question about "forgery." It is assumed you will donate the work- so if the work is to be framed, that cost needs to be considered. More details to come.

The Corowa district Landcare Group- have also asked AWAS to participate in an exhibition they are organising next year. More details to come on this.

VISION Australia is considering running another art group for the Vision impaired, this time in Wodonga. 3 AWAS members, Meg Sprouster, Noni McClelland and I run a 2 hour Monday art group at Mirumbeena, North Albury. (Remember the exhibition we put on at the studio last year?) It is a really rewarding experience to be involved with these enthusiastic artists.
