THE WODONGA / ALBURY COMBINED ARTS AND CULTURE FESTIVAL MARCH 6-9 2020

AWAS Vice President Terri Friesan attended the Gateway Tenancy Meeting in June. This major 2020 event was the main topic of discussion.

Here is the plan so far for the 4 day event:

Friday 6th Venue: Albury Riverside Norieul Park.

Saturday 7th am Venue: Wodonga Belvoir Park, Albury Library Museum and MAMA.

Evening Venue: The Cube (Music/art/drama/circus/food) and Street art mural reveal.

Sunday 8th 10am - 3pm **Venue: Albury**. Riverside art markets, "Brunch "food. AWAS artists working "plein air" to promote Monday's open gallery at the Causeway.

Monday 9th 9am -1pm **Venue: Causeway**. Promotion of markets and Galleries by the council. Open galleries, workshops, outdoor art.
