Saturday Acrylic Painting Group

Acrylic and Mixed Media-mini workshop

This month the Acrylic and Mixed Media group decided to experiment with Flow Acrylics to create some very interesting and random abstract works of art. We have been very lucky to add Hope Hayman to our Saturday group, who has added a new dimension to our art by showing us how to create these pictures. She has done a number of beautiful paintings using this technique, so after our last General Meeting we asked if we could set up the means to experiment with the technique ourselves.

Hope organised to get the necessary materials and demonstrated how to mix the Floetrol and the acrylic, getting it to the right consistency to pour. We all created some novel pictures and thoroughly enjoyed the experience and the chance, for some of us at least, to step out of our comfort zone!

It was an amazingly successful day, so much so that we are looking forward to trying our hand at improving on our first attempt and adding in some ways of creating abstracts with sieves and sponges and anything else we can think of next month.

While this was an experiment confined to the Saturday Acrylic and Mixed Media group, if others wish to try it out, we may be able to conduct a mini one day workshop next year, if Hope can help us! I want to thank Hope for her enthusiasm and willingness to run last Saturday. It wouldn't have happened without her. Jill Scanlon.

I will be interested in your opinion on this. Keep in mind we have to take easels, materials etc. There are some interesting background props and shady trees on the property.

SPECIAL TUTORED WORKSHOPS IN 2020

Expressions of interest are sought now for those members interested in an Acrylic/Mixed Media/ sketchbook Workshop with well-known Victorian artist/tutor Catherine Hamilton. The weekend workshop is 21st and 22nd of March.

Here is Catherine's description she gave me in an email recently:

I can offer some new ideas and something that you feel will be a little different for everyone. It can be painting or drawing mediums and also I run a sketchbook drawing workshop that includes making your own sketchbooks. This has gone down well with many students and I also go through various sketching mediums including various inks and drawing materials. The new drawing workshop is a mixed media drawing incorporating charcoal, graphite and ink as well as using coloured pigment as well. Beautiful river scenes and trees lend themselves well as the subject.

Those who remember the 2 workshops we had with her a few years ago (acrylic, inks and pastel), it was full on information, experimental and inspiring! Catherine has a chemistry background, so is well versed in the use of various acrylic mediums and fixatives.

Comments by workshop participants referred to her professional teaching, creative ideas and energy. All were inspired to expand their use of art materials. We were also entertained by her Mr Bean impersonations!
