
WECOME BACK TO THE STUDIO!

Members with keys can access the studio, being mindful to follow guidelines: no more that 16 can be working in the studio, less when tables and easels are constricting access to wash-up facilities.

- The studio is closed to the public.
- Follow all hygiene signage.
- Follow social distancing requirements.
- Only 1 person in the kitchen at a time.
- Bring all your own food, drink and utensils.
- No shared food.
- Clean all used surfaces with cleaning agents supplied.

SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING for DEREGISTERING IN NSW

During October members were notified of a Special General Meeting called to vote on a Constitutional change.

A small subcommittee has been meeting over the past 12 months to examine the details in the two State Model Constitutions and our AWAS Constitution. To be registered in two states was previously advantageous, but it was determined that it unnecessarily complicates our procedures. Those present at the Special General Meeting unanimously voted to follow the subcommittee's proposal and adopt the Victorian Model Constitution only. Using one Model constitution only now simplifies our obligations and savings can be made in registration fees.

The meeting was on on 28th October at Donna Johnstone's home in Albury. Thanks Donna for making your home available and making the space Covid friendly for the meeting.
