### *Farewell Kasper Wiss.*

*At the end of last year one of our senior artists Kasper Wiss passed away. While he did not attend the studio very often, he would come to The Wodonga Plant Farm on the days we changed over our exhibitions in the cafe, bringing in his exquisitely detailed paintings.*

As we put 2021 behind us, with all the stops and starts with workshops, hopefully we all have some artwork in the making and are keen to take part in some of our exhibitions, studio activities and perhaps an art field trip or two with other members.

Already the AWAS committee has met, renewed our lease with the Wodonga Council, paid some bills and discussed some of the issues about sales commissions, OH&S, COVID-19 and publicity. We are starting to plan workshops and exhibitions for 2022. Please consider being part of the committee: we need input from members.

### **Here are some points from our meeting:**

- **AWAS charges 15% Commission on sales** for artworks sold at both the studio and Wodonga Plant Farm AWAS exhibitions. Artists should add this 15% in their calculations when pricing their artworks. If the item for sale is \$30 or under (mostly cards at the studio) no commission is charged- the full marked price goes to the artist. This policy is written in our members' information booklet. (Available online and a copy is in our library).
- **Keeping the studio free of clutter-** of ongoing concern. Please take home artworks from previous exhibitions and workshops. Work left to dry needs to be collected within a few days, not stored in the studio.
- As a working studio, easels, tables and chairs are needed. **Leave out 2 or 3 tables in the studio, pushed against the wall** to allow easier viewing of the artworks on display. Easels are to be returned to the middle room. To continue to put tables away increases wear and tear on the furniture and members often struggle with collapsing the tables and transporting them to store. Leaving them out is more convenient, but as we are open to the public the clutter presents a tripping hazard and impedes cleaning the floor. OH&S door signs will be made.
- The welfare of our members needs to take priority when making decisions about **implementing COVID-19 protocols** for AWAS events and informal day-to-day access to the studio for members and the public. While we cannot discriminate against non-vaccinated people, the AWAS membership demographic is mostly vulnerable. A door sign will be created stating that for the protection of all, we encourage only fully vaccinated visitors should enter the studio to view our exhibitions. Coordinators of AWAS events need to be able to make decisions about specific cases, considering the welfare and risks in each case.



## EXHIBITIONS AT THE STUDIO



The 4 - day Life Drawing Marathon workshop during January was enjoyed by 13 participants, although not everyone had the stamina for all sessions! We had no tutor, so each person was able to explore their own investigations and interpretations of the figure. Life Drawing artworks on exhibition at the studio will remain until Saturday March 5th.
