#### **STUDIO NEWS**

- New signs have been posted on the Studio door bringing visitors' attention to safety issues entering the studio/gallery. # STUDIO EXHIBITION: Life Drawing exhibition Closes.

Members have appreciated the work of the Coordinators Judy Balfour and Olga Juskiw in running workshops in the last 6 months and organizing the really informative post workshop exhibitions.

The Life Drawing exhibition ends March 5th. Jill Scanlon and helpers will be hanging the next studio exhibition on Wednesday 9th March and ask members to bring in their artworks (any theme and art medium) for our studio display for the next two months.

#### **AWAS MEMBERS EXHIBITION 2022**

After some discussion at our General Meeting last month it was felt that we should have an annual members' exhibition this year, keeping the criteria broad to cater for many interests- so the most acceptable suggestion for a title for publicity was:

#### "The 2022 AWAS Annual Members' Exhibition."

The date will be set by the committee- the suggestion was late winter, perhaps mid -September, avoiding Life Drawing (1st weekend of the month), and the AGM.

Artworks- Max. size 1sq metre. They must not have been displayed in any AWAS exhibitions before. They must not be a work done during a TUTORED workshop. Art works are to be labelled on the back with artist's contact details, title, art medium and price and be ready to hang.

As the exhibition is to be open to the public and advertised, the studio must be open and manned for the advertised dates and times. Exhibitors must be prepared to take their turn in being placed on the duty roster and conduct sales.

When pricing your artwork, in addition to the value of the artwork itself, add in the cost of the frame and the commission to those organising the exhibition. AWAS policy is that the 15% commission applies to artworks in both studio and plant Farm venues, except when the item is valued \$30 or under (mostly cards).
