APRIL WEDNESDAY INFORMAL get-together at lunchtime. (Every 2nd month)

• A small group of members got together on our informal chat and lunch Wednesday 17th April. Rebekah suggested that it would be good to see more experimental work, for example using fibre. (Does anyone have any experience doing Latch-hook work??) This led to a discussion about various possibilities- what others have tried, workshops available and how we could have sessions in our studio sharing our experiences. In the past the acrylic/mixed media group have had short sessions using acrylic pours (can be expensive, but apparently there are some cheap alternatives).

Perhaps some members have some techniques using dyes, collage using fabric and threads or other materials they could share in a short session eg 2 hours one day?? Perhaps a series of 2 hour sessions?

Arising from this was the suggestion-

Let's have a "painting on unusual surfaces" exhibition!

Car doors, tables etc were mentioned.

- Another suggestion was for a special painting theme for all members: inspired by the famous historical Early Australian Impressionist exhibition, the 9"x5" Exhibition.
 Artworks were all done on cigar box lids of that dimension.

 AWAS had a special exhibition on this theme 10 years ago.
 It might be fun to revisit this, perhaps with a new twist? Any ideas?
- It was suggested by Jill, who coordinates the Acrylic/mixed media group, that we set aside the 3rd Saturday of the month specifically for EXPERIMENTAL ART. Please contact her with any suggestions, especially if you would like to participate, or demonstrate, a technique which others might be interested in.
- Reviving our Portrait sessions. Once held on the 3rd Saturday of the month. Perhaps one-off sessions to be organised with a paid model. A coordinator (or team of two?) is needed to set the date and book the model. The model could be your neighbor, friend, or someone you know who has an interesting face!

If you can help put any of these suggestions into action, let the committee know- email me, (the Secretary and Newsletter editor), and it can be discussed at the following Committee meeting and General meeting.
